Contestant Rules and Regulations

- Participants must provide their own ingredients, and cooking utensils necessary to prepare their dish.
- Park opens at 8:00 am. All participants should be set up by 11:30 am
- To qualify as a contestant you must be between the ages of 8-17 years old.
- Contestants are allowed to prepare any dish of their choice
- An adult over the age of 18 years old must accompany contestants.
- Contestants are required to have the consent and signature of their parent or legal guardian
- Contestants must adhere to all health, electrical, fire and other codes whether city, county, state or federal.
- Contestants must provide at least 20 lbs of their dish for crowd sampling to be considered for the Kiddie Cook-off Award.
- **CONTESTANTS MUST USE SAMPLE CUPS PROVIDED TO THEM BY THE CARIBBEAN COOK-OFF FOR CROWD SAMPLING, VIOLATION OF THIS RULE WILL DISQUALIFY YOU FROM THE COMPETITION.**
- **Contestants may not sell to the public. ANY VIOLATION OF THIS RULE AUTOMATICALLY DISQUALIFIES YOU FROM THE COMPETITION**
- Each dish may be presented with an appropriate accompaniment and garnish of your choice.
- All contestants must wear aprons and loose hair should be pulled back.
- All contestants must maintain a clean cooking area.
- Food must be displayed in sampling cups provided by the Caribbean Cook-off
- Spaces are approximately 10' x 10' in size.
- Some form of food preparation should be done on the premises
- Contestant booths are subject to a random inspection at any time.
